***Head Injury Letter***

Today, \_\_\_\_\_, received an injury to the head. Your child was seen in the clinic and had no problem at that time, but you should watch for any of the following symptoms:

1. Severe headache.
2. Excessive drowsiness. (wake the child at least twice during the night)
3. Nausea and/or vomiting.
4. Double vision, blurred vision, or pupils of different sizes.
5. Loss of muscle coordination such as falling down, walking strangely, or staggering.
6. Any unusual behavior such as being confused, breathing irregularly, or being dizzy.
7. Convulsion/Seizures
8. Bleeding or discharge from an ear.
9. Please DO NOT give Acetaminophen, Ibuprofen or Aspirin prior to checking with your Primary Care Provider.
